

# SADBERGE ENERGY SAVING PROJECT



## Progress Report

As of 31<sup>st</sup> January 2009:-

- 61 Sadberge households have received free low energy light bulbs (supplied by EDF Energy).
- 39 households have borrowed Eco-eye electricity monitors to investigate their patterns of electricity use.
- 2 households with members aged 70 or over have had free loft installation installed, and four more are waiting for their installation appointments.
- 2 households have had cavity wall insulation installed at a subsidised cost under the 'Able to Pay' scheme.
- 3 households have had loft insulation installed under the 'Able to Pay' scheme.
- 2 households have placed orders for new central heating boilers.

The Sadberge Energy Saving Project has been short-listed for an Evening Chronicle Environment Award.

## Infra-Red Photographs
